On Sunday, March 24, 2024, Aaron G Pepin, “Pep”, passed away unexpectedly at age 51.

Aaron was born in Brunswick, Maine on August 17, 1972, to Gerald and Christina (Viger) Pepin. He grew up on Beacon Street in Bath, Maine, attended Bath schools and graduated from Morse High School in 1990. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the US Army where he served for 2 years, after which he remained active in the Army Reserves for an additional 5 years. During his time in the Reserves he also attended the University of Southern Maine for a short period of time. In 1992 he relocated to St. Augustine, Florida where his restaurant journey began. He managed several of St. Augustine’s favorite local hot spots: The Oasis, The Conch House, Zhanras, Sunset Grille, and South Beach Grill just to name a few. Aaron then decided to make a career change and became a licensed Realtor. He embarked on his journey starting at Waston Realty and transitioned to Sunshine Realty. In 2019 he became a member of the Publix Super Markets family, where he quickly worked his way up to Assistant Deli Manager.

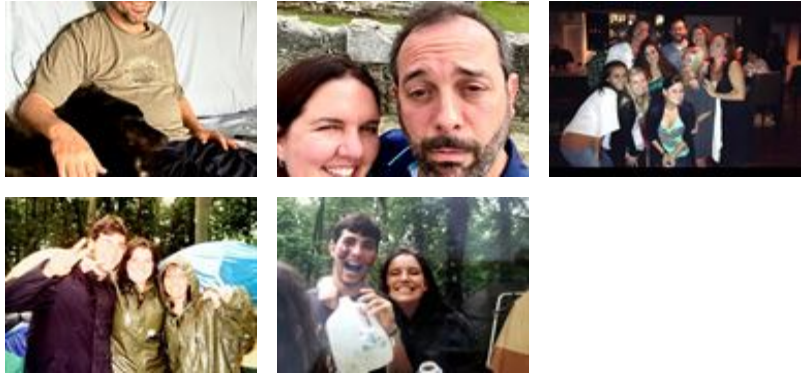

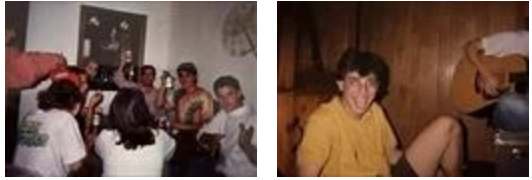
