After business school, she moved to Ottawa to work in the House of Commons and for a film producer. There she met and married Hugh Wilson in 1947. They lived in the Ottawa area for 11 years until lured to Ann Arbor, Michigan in time for Adele to be delivered of their fourth baby three weeks after they arrived. Thirty-three years later they moved to Palm Coast, Florida and then to World Golf Village. Adele was easy to love because she radiated so much of it. She epitomized "JOY" through the value system she adopted during her stay in Ottawa : giving her attention to Jesus first then, to Others later, to herself . Her Christian dedication took her into several significant leadership roles throughout her life. Her Christian faith was at the focus of everything she did and wherever she went she demonstrated the importance of that way of life.
