Alan Vega, 72, of Windermere, Florida, passed away after a courageous battle with prostate cancer on September 16, 2022 with his daughter Bri by his side. During his final days he was surrounded by family and close friends. He was born and raised in Stillwater, NY. Alan graduated from The University of Maine with his bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering and a member of Delta Tau Delta. After graduating he went to work for the paper company formally called SD Warren, now known as SAPPI. Over his career he lived in Maryland, New Jersey, Illinois and Massachusetts as he worked his way to Vice President of Sales. In 2014 he retired and moved to Florida, where he enjoyed playing golf and fishing.

For 9 years he was his daughter Bri's caddy while she was a professional golfer. In his earlier years Alan also enjoyed racing; starting out in late models then Sportsman Modified stock cars, and later moving onto Formula Fours. However, more than anything he enjoyed spending time with his family and grandchildren.

He is survived by his daughters, Briana Blakefield (Mark) and Wendi Torkelson (Ken); grandchildren, Matthew, Brooks and Brynlee; and his sister Betsy Judkins and nephews Chad (Jenny) and Kyle (Kyle), and many cousins. He was preceded in death by his wife, Sheila Vega; parents, Valentine, Jr. and Shirley Vega and a brother, Paul Vega.
