



## Alfred Andrew Tenneson, Jr.

It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Alfred (also known as "Al" or "Dusty") Andrew Tenneson Jr., who left this world on April 4, 2026, at the age of 71. Born on May 28, 1954, in Fargo, North Dakota, Alfred's journey through life was marked by resilience and warmth. He lived many places during his formative years including Morehead, Dillworth and St Cloud, Minnesota, Miami, FL and Iron Mountain, Michigan. He was a graduate of Iron Mountain High School. After graduating from high school, Alfred proudly served his country in the U.S. Army, stationed near Frankfurt, Germany.
