Amanda Heffron Morgan, age 72 entered into eternal rest on April 13, 2023 at her home in St. Augustine, FL. Amanda was born on February 4, 1951 in Charleston, SC to parents Mary (Creel) and Charles Joseph Heffron. She grew up in Charleston and was a 1969 graduate of College Preparatory School. She attended Newberry College and The University of South Carolina before training to become a stewardess for Eastern Airlines. Amanda was the quintessential stewardess. She was beautiful, vibrant, and full of life. She worked for Eastern for 20 years and met her husband, and love-of-her-life, Eastern Airline pilot MC Morgan, marrying him in 1978. After retiring in the early 1990's, Amanda and MC moved to St. Augustine and lived in the Marsh Creek community. Amanda was a talented wildlife photographer and became very involved in the St. Augustine arts community. She owned an art gallery and gift shop in the historic district of St. Augustine.

In addition to her parents, Amanda was preceded in death by her husband MC Morgan. She is survived by a sister-in-law, Joyce (Terry- deceased) Heffron; a sister, Marsha Heffron of Ladson, SC; and a brother, Charles J. Heffron, Jr. and his wife, Jane of Charleston, SC. 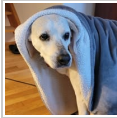

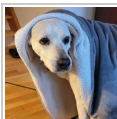
