Andrew W. "Arty" Froehlich, age 83, of St. Augustine, died on January 18, at his residence. Born in Brooklyn, New York, he was a longtime resident of Hamilton Square, N.J. before moving to St. Augustine in 1990. Arty began his working life with Railway Express in Princeton Jct, New Jersey before leaving to serve his country in the U.S. Army during W.W. II. After the war he returned to Princeton, N.J. and began working with his brother in the family business; Bohrens (United) Moving & Storage Co. as a driver, and later worked in the front office of the business for many years. Upon retirement and moving to St. Augustine, Andrew drove the Flagler Hospital shuttle bus for the Council on Aging. He was a member of Memorial Presbyterian Church. He survived by his wife, June C. Froehlich of St. Augustine, sons, William Froehlich and his wife, Linda of St. Augustine, Wayne Froehlich of Palmyra, N.J., daughters, Nancy Lentini and her husband, Dr. Larry of Newtown, Pa., Gayle Cromwell and her husband William of Fort Loudin, Pa., a brother, Fred Froehlich of St. Augustine, and five grandchildren.
