Angelo Sebastian "Bert" Bertolino, age 89, of St. Augustine, passed away peacefully on February 16, 2012 at his home, surrounded by his family. Bert was born in Rochester, New York, where he graduated from Jefferson High School. After serving his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII for three and a half years, he went on to attend New York University and the Academy of Advanced Traffic. Mr. Bertolino became an International Traffic Manager in International Exporting for Dayton Price Limited in New York, where he served from 1946 to 1982, and later worked as an agent in the Real Estate and Insurance Industries. Bert was also a talented carpenter, who spent much time building and renovating homes nights and on weekends. It was his passion to work with wood. In 1998 he relocated to St. Augustine, where he became a member of Anastasia Baptist Church. His family is proud of his accomplishments, including the fact that he was the recipient of Navy Military Honors. He is survived by his wife, Marie Bertolino, of St. Augustine; sons, John Bertolino and his wife, Paula, of Newbern, North Carolina and Thomas Bertolino and his wife, Terry, of St. John, Virgin Islands; a sister, Nancy Bredice of Burlington, Vermont; brothers, Joseph Bertolino of Cortez, Colorado and Emil Bertolino, and his wife, Ruth, of Newbern, NC; and his grandchildren, Catherine Higgins, and her husband, Michael, and Michael and Kaitlyn Bertolino. He was preceded in death by two brothers, David Bertolino
