Anne Morck Martin, age 88, of St. Augustine, died peacefully on September 19, at her home. Anne was born in Frankfurt, Germany and was a longtime resident of New Rochelle, N.Y. before moving to St. Augustine 15 years ago. As a youth, Anne was a member of the German National Swim Team and qualified for the 1936 Olympic games in the starting jump and in the 50-meter breaststroke. A holocaust survivor, she immigrated with her family to the United States in 1939. Anne was a graduate of N.Y.U., and worked as a paralegal for Coudert Brothers Law Firm in Manhattan for more than 30 years. She was a member of the New Rochelle Young Women's Republican Club, having served as their President and upon moving to St. Augustine, she was a member of Temple Bet Yam where she was active with the Sunshine Committee. A son, Dennis M. Martin of St. Augustine, survives her. Her husband, Leon S. Martin, preceded her in death in 1984. Private services will be held in New York at a later date.
