Anthony Leon Bunting, age 55, passed away unexpectedly on May 31, 2022, at his home in St. Johns, FL. Anthony was born on February 27, 1967, in Conway, AR to parents Leon Bunting and Charlene Benton. Growing up in Conway, he was a 1985 graduate of Conway High School. He joined the US Navy right out of high school and served four years as a reservist before active duty called him for another 20 years. Anthony retired in 2014 as a Senior Chief and had received numerous commendations, citations, awards, and medals. After retiring for service, Anthony continued serving as a civil servant working as a Lead Structural Planner for the US Navy at Mayport. He enjoyed being at home, tinkering on things around the house, and spending time with his family. He was a member of Bethel Baptist Church in Jacksonville. He will be deeply missed by his family and friends.

“ Remembering our friend and shipmate, DCC (SW) Anthony L. Bunting, USN (Ret.) Anthony Bunting

Chief Bunting passed away unexpectedly yesterday. He was a great friend; one of a kind and a very dedicated engineer. I met Chief Bunting during my Second Division Officer tour as the Auxiliaries Mechanical Officer aboard USS SIMPSON (FFG 56) in October 2011. He was the Top Snipe and always willing to assist. For months, I did not have an Engineman Chief in my Division. Chief filled that gap and played a pivotal role to ensure that all auxiliaries equipment were ready to support all operational tasking.

As my Acting Division Chief, he would point me in the right direction when I was off course. As the EOOW trainer, Chief was unwilling to just sign off EOOW PQS. He would give the candidate a tour of the spaces and explained how the system works. He always ensured that the EOOW Trainee understands the concepts and the reason behind everything. Chief loved the FFG 7 Frigate and knew every piping system aboard the ship. He knew the engineering plant like the back of his hands. I recalled a situation where a gauge was flickering on the Propulsion Plant console during our watch section. Chief quickly called the Sound and Security Watch to manipulate a valve in the space and the flickering immediately stopped. My first training encounter with Chief Bunting was when I was working on my EOOW requalification upon reporting for duty on SIMPSON. During one of our conversations, I told him that I had qualified EOOW on my last ship and that I would like to re-qualify. He laughed and put an immediate hold on my EOOW designation letter from the Captain. Chief indicated that I was not ready until I passed his test. By joining and training with his watch team weeks later, I was more confident and ready to lead my own engineering watch team. This is how great and dedicated Chief Bunting was at his job.

When it comes to mentorship, Chief was there for the upward mobility of both junior officers and his Sailors. He has mentored many Sailors to achieve greater heights in their naval careers.

Several of them today are Master Chiefs, Senior Chiefs, Chiefs and Junior Officers in the World's Greatest Navy. Chief Bunting was funny and a no nonsense Damage Controlman Chief. He was a man every Sailor would want to talk to in time of distress on the ship. He was a man of great wisdom, technical expertise, and the highest integrity that I know. We will miss DCC so very much. Although he has transitioned to the great beyond, but we give God all the glory for a life well lived and many Sailors whose lives he touched. For his family and loved ones that he left behind, I pray that the good lord gives them the fortitude to bear this irreparable loss. May the Almighty God grant him eternal rest. Amen.
