



Anthony Patrick "Tony" Dellaglio

November 7, 1943 - November 23, 2023

Anthony Patrick "Tony" Dellaglio, age 80, of St. Augustine, passed away on November 23, 2023 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring in St. Augustine, FL.. Tony was born on November 7, 1943 to parents Joseph and Frances (Varacalli) Dellaglio. He grew up in Jersey City and attended McCook College where he played quarterback on the school's football team. After graduation Tony moved to Guttenberg, NJ and went to work for JP Morgan Bank in New York. He continued his education while at JP Morgan, getting his Bachelors in Fine Arts from the School of Visual Arts in New York City. After starting at JP Morgan in an entry level position, Tony rose through the ranks to become Vice President of Marketing where he developed the graphics and marketing materials for the company. Tony was talented and creative and was very successful in his career of over 30 years with JP Morgan. He retired in the late 1990's and moved to Rancho Bernardo, California to live close to his sister, Frances, with whom he was especially close. He followed Frances and her family to St. Augustine in 2019. Tony enjoyed great relationships during his life. He was a loving son, had many lifelong friends, and he loved his sister and her family dearly. He was gifted athletically and artistically. He enjoyed painting, played the piano, was an accomplished photographer and an avid reader. He also enjoyed a fine collection of European cars during his lifetime. An avid golfer, he experienced the thrill of a hole in one. Tony was loved by his family and friends and will be deeply missed. He believed in giving back and was a supporter of St Jude's Children's Hospital.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Frances Dellaglio. He is survived by his sister, Frances Harrigan and her husband Richard of St. Augustine, FL.; nieces, Kelly Steger and her husband Tom of St Augustine, FL, Dana Harrigan of Jacksonville, FL., Colleen Phaneuf of Jupiter, FL; and great nieces, Jessica, Erin, and Caitlin.
