Antoinette Massimino DeCarlo, “Grandma Toni,” died on July 3, 2024, in St. Augustine, FL at the age of 96. She was a devoted Christian, modeling the love of Christ to all she met. She loved her family unconditionally and centered her life around her faith and family.

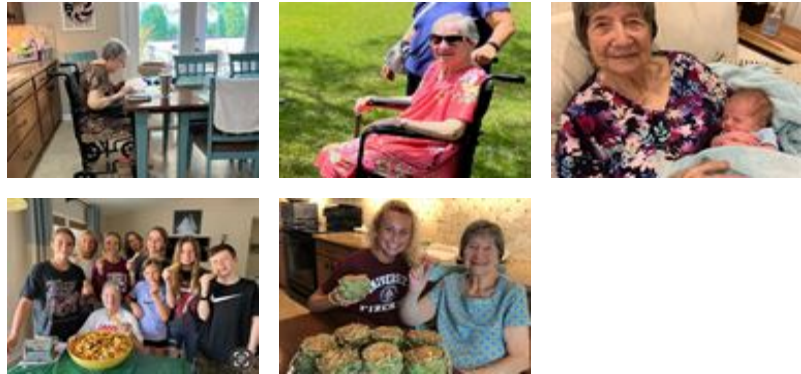
