Barbara Camden Glace (nee Graham), 92, died September 13, 2023, peacefully at home. Born February 6, 1931, in Indianapolis, Indiana, her family moved to SE Ohio in 1941 and she lived in Cincinnati from 1949 until 1977, graduating from The Christ Hospital School of Nursing in 1952. Barbara loved being a Registered Nurse and especially the last 13 years of nursing while in the Emergency Room at Christ Hospital. She was a cheerful and positive person who dearly loved her family and cherished time spent with all of them through the years. Her church was always important to her and she was an active member of Memorial Lutheran Church.
