Barbara Ann Lamb, age 90, of St. Augustine passed away on October 10, 2024, at the Bailey Family Center for Caring in St Augustine, FL. Barbara was born on April 17, 1934 in St. Joe, Michigan to parents Harry and Mildred Bullard. Barbara grew up in Benton Harbor, Michigan and after graduating high school she attended nursing school at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. It was during this time that Barbara met her husband-to-be-, Frederic D. Lamb, who was attending law school at the University of Michigan. Barb and Fred met at a school dance and Fred was heard to say "that's the girl that I'm going to marry" just after their first date. His prediction came true on April 6, 1954. After Fred graduated with his law degree in 1956 they moved to the New York city area for two years and then to Forest Park, Ohio a suburb of Cincinnati, Ohio. Barbara was a dedicated mother and industrious homemaker and raised a family of two children. Her home was beautifully decorated and lacked for nothing. It was a place of welcoming hospitality. Barbara enjoyed an active life. A member of Silver Spring Country Club, she was an avid golfer and a champion bridge player. She also enjoyed tennis, bowling, and knitting. Barbara had been a resident of St. Augustine since 2018. At age 86, Barbara was baptized and became a member of Anastasia Baptist Church. She will be deeply missed by her family and friends.
