



## Barbro Pellborn Tadlock

September 10, 1936 - August 1, 2022

Barbro Pellborn Tadlock, 85, St. Augustine, Florida, died on August 1, 2022 at Baptist Medical Center Jacksonville, Florida.

Barbro was born and raised in Gothenburg, Sweden, graduating with honors from high school and teachers' college. She was an elementary school teacher in Sweden before she met, fell in love with, and, in 1961, married her American pen-pal, Warren.

On April 9th, 1963 she became an American citizen, a day she proudly celebrated annually.

She bravely set off from Sweden, starting a married life filled with travel and adventure. She lived in Liberia, Yemen, and Laos before moving with her family to St. Augustine, Florida in 1975.

In St Augustine, she worked as a Business Manager for the Lightner Museum from 1977-1983, then as a guide for the Sanchez house on St George Street. She served as a substitute teacher at a variety of elementary schools and volunteered her time in the community with the Friends of the Library.

She was a woman of immense integrity, had a passion for language and learning, while also being artistic and creative. She built and fostered many

friendships over the years through her work, travel, fellowship with her Monday Swedish group, and various hobbies to include quilting, scrapbooking, bridge, and genealogy research. A pen-pal at heart, she continued to write to her Swedish childhood friends and family, and kept in touch with many families from her time overseas.

She will be most remembered by her family for her unconditional love, kindness, honesty, humility and contagious smile.

A memorial service and celebration of her life will be held at 1:00 p.m. Sunday September 4, 2022 at St. Johns Family Funeral Home.
