Brenda Elaine Smith Labrecque passed away April 28, 2026, at Flagler Hospital in St Augustine, FL.

Brenda was born on March 15, 1951, in Jacksonville, FL, to the late Carl A Smith Sr. and Aura Grimes Smith.

In addition to her parents, Brenda was preceded in death by her youngest son, Daniel Pittman, 2 husbands, Rick Pittman and Jack Kovalcik, and a grandson, Johnathan Pittman.

Brenda worked for Southern Bell Telephone Company in Jacksonville, FL. then Prosperity / Ameris Bank in St Augustine, FL. In addition to her full-time employment, Brenda spent many years volunteering, counseling, and assisting juvenile crime victims through the Guardian Ad Litem Program in St Johns County. Brenda was a devoted servant of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, having taught children's Sunday school classes at Central Baptist Church in Jacksonville and Trinity Christian Fellowship in St Augustine. 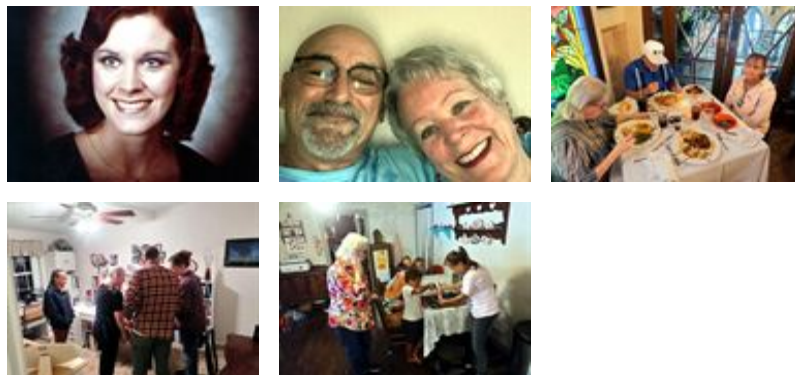
