Carole Delp, 66, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away on October 13, 2024, at Flagler Hospital. Born in Billingham, England, Carole moved to Zephyrhills, Florida, in 1991, where she lived for many years before relocating to St. Augustine four years ago.

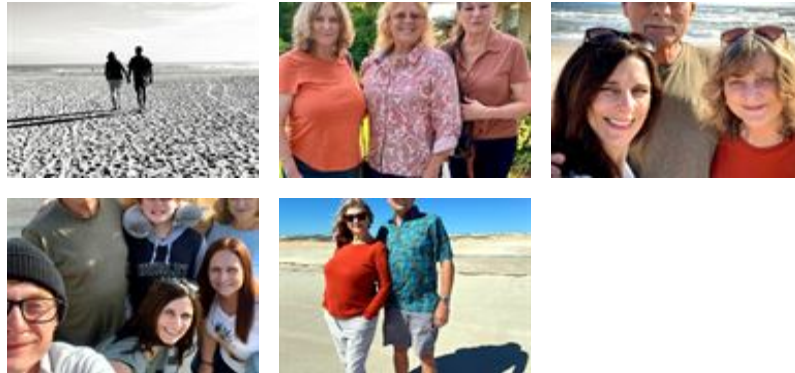
