Carolyn Ferrence Carver, 81, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away peacefully on June 27, 2025, at UF Health Flagler Hospital.

Born in Peckville, Pennsylvania, Carolyn was the daughter of the late John Anthony and Alpha Ferrence. A dedicated educator and talented artist, she earned a bachelor's degree in Art Education and History from the University of Georgia. Carolyn went on to teach art and history in the public school systems of Atlanta, Georgia; Cairo, Georgia; and Clarks Green, Pennsylvania, until her retirement.
