Charles Scott “Charlie” Anderson, age 41, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, July 31, 2019. Born to Scott and RaeAnn Anderson in Duluth, Minnesota, Charlie grew up in Floodwood, Minnesota and was a 1996 graduate of Floodwood High School. After the September 11, 2001 attack on our country, Charlie felt compelled to serve his country by enlisting in the U.S. Army.
