Charles W. Grizzard, age 86, of St. Augustine, passed away on June 15, 2019 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring. He was born in Bowdon, GA and grew up in Carrollton, GA. After high school he moved to Big Spring, TX and joined the U.S. Army, where he served his country for 4 years. While in the Army Charles married his wife Eva Joyce Grizzard, the couple moved back to Big Spring, TX where they raised their family. His great love was being the choir director of Birdwell Lane Baptist Choir from 1953 to 1976. Charles went to work for the Civil Service for many years as an engine mechanic and in management. They then moved to Texarkana, TX where he continued to work and lead church choirs. Charles retired from the Civil Service to San Angelo with his wife, where they loved traveling the United States in their RV. He filled his years helping people, stopping along the way to help build churches and Christian schools. Charles traveled the U.S. in his RV until he was 78. Family and friends were his first concern, they meant the world to him. His wife, Joyce was always by his side, they did everything together. He was a devoted husband and loving father grandfather, brother and friend, who will be missed deeply.
