Charlotte Van Cura Marchioli, age 97, of St. Augustine, passed away on September 28, 2011 at her residence in St. Augustine surrounded by her family. Born and raised in Greenport, Long Island, New York, Charlotte was a longtime resident of Southold, L.I., before moving to Ocala in the mid 1970's. She had resided in St. Augustine since 1978. Charlotte founded Van Cura Braided Rugs in Southold, and operated the company for 24 years, retiring in 1974. The custom rugs that she made by hand were in high demand, though it took nearly a month to produce a 9" by 12" rug. She was a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church and served as Senior Vice Commander of the St. Augustine unit of the D.A.V.A. and served as Aide to the State Commander. She is survived by her husband, Nicholas Marchioli, of St. Augustine; daughters, Barbara Joan Van Cura of Summerfield, FL, and Charlene Frances Van Cura of St. Augustine; a son, Robert Edward Van Cura, of Brooklet, Georgia; 10 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by a daughter, Dorothy Gallagher, and her first husband, Edward J. Van Cura. A memorial service will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 15th at St. Johns Family Funeral Home. Interment will be in San Lorenzo Cemetery. St. Johns Family Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
