



## Cherrie Colleen Hall

October 14, 1946 - April 20, 2020

Cherrie Colleen Hall, age 73, passed away on April 20, 2020 from Ovarian Cancer. Cherrie was born and raised in Ontario, Canada. After graduating from high school, she worked as a Residence Counselor at the Ontario School for the Deaf in Milton, Ontario. She met her husband, St. Augustine native LTC (Ret) Ronald Hall, when she came to St. Augustine for Spring Break with some of her co-workers.

After marriage, she moved many times...wherever the US Army sent her husband...and raised three children along the way. Summers were almost always spent in St. Augustine with extended family.
