Cheryl Lynn Stofer, 75, St. Augustine, died January 26, 2023 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring with her daughter by her side. 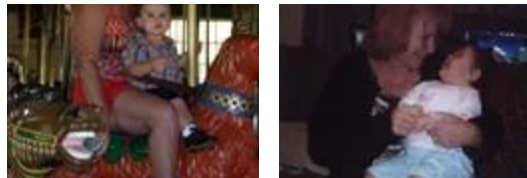

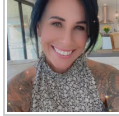
