Clara Elizabeth Sullivan, 93, St. Augustine, died May 31, 2013 at the Clyde E. Lassen State Veterans' Nursing Home. A native of Dubuque, Iowa, Clara has resided in St. Augustine since 1968, moving here from Jacksonville. Clara was a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, having served during WW II. She later became a medical secretary and worked for different neurosurgeons in Jacksonville. After moving to St. Augustine, Clara worked in the Admissions office at Flagler Hospital on Marine Street and later retired from St. Augustine General Hospital. After retirement, Clara went to work in the Dental Clinic at the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind and worked for the St. Johns County Tax Collector's office until her final retirement. Clara was a member of the Marine Corps League. Private services are planned, with interment at the National Cemetery in Jacksonville.
