Clifford Elmore, age 77, of St. Augustine, passed away on July 2, 2025, at his home in St. Augustine, FL. Clifford was born on May 10, 1948 in St. Augustine, FL, to Eddie and Queen Esther (nee Salley) Elmore and was a lifelong resident of St. Augustine. He grew up in a tight-knit family of five brothers and one sister. He was a 1967 graduate of Richard J. Murray High School. Clifford also enjoyed traveling and partaking in cultural events. One of his proud travels was to see his favorite team, the Dallas Cowboys. He was deeply loved and appreciated by his family and friends. He and his infectious laugh will be greatly missed.
