Clive William Wang, 79 years old, passed away peacefully on June 12, 2026.

He was born on April 6, 1947, in London, England, and raised in Montreal, Quebec, where he spent his formative years playing as much hockey as he could.

Clive followed his passion for the ice to the University of Illinois, ultimately skating his way to All American in 1970, but not before earning the Award of the Bronze Star Medal for his military service as a Sergeant in the Vietnam War from 1967 to 1968. He spent his professional life in the leather business, where he was known for his deep knowledge and strong relationships.

Clive will be remembered for his love of family and the Montreal Canadiens, his unwavering loyalty, perseverance, positivity, a smile that spread from ear to ear, and big teddy bear hugs.

He is survived by his loving wife, Deanne; his daughter and son-in-law, Adeeva and Jay Fritz; his daughter and son-in-law, Stephanie and Cassidy McTigue; and his four grandchildren, Cara, Ellie, Finnegan, and Colson.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Leo and Ada Wang, and his brother, Michael Wang.
