Delmas H. "Steve" Stevers, 81, St. Augustine, passed away April 29, 2017 at Baptist Medical Center South. He was born July 1, 1935 in Logan, W. Virginia and spent his youth in Crown City, Ohio. He graduated from Gallia Academy High School in 1953 and immediately joined the U.S. Army. He served during the Korean Conflict, stationed in Germany. After being honorably discharged from the Army in 1956 he enrolled in college at Marshall University, graduating with a degree in business, and then he moved to Jacksonville, Florida, where he resided until relocating to Ponte Vedra in 1991. He most recently moved to St. Augustine in 2015. Steve was formerly employed with the Charter Company as a senior executive until his retirement. He was a former pitcher with the NY Giants and played with Willie Mays during a spring training stint. As an avid golfer, Steve was also a former member of the Ponte Vedra Club where he enjoyed playing golf there as well as at Sawgrass. He and his wife, Vicki, loved to travel the world but the biggest joy in his life were his family and friends, whom he loved dearly. He is survived by his loving wife of 34 years, Vicki Davis Stevers, originally of Jacksonville, now residing in St. Augustine; one son, Marc Stevers, Jacksonville; and grandson, Ryan Stevers, also of Jacksonville. He was preceded in death by his parents and his only brother, Dwight.
