DENNIS CLYDE APPLGATE, 72, beloved father of four, passed away peacefully in Jacksonville, Florida on December 8, 2025, after a nine-year journey with Parkinson's disease. Even in his most challenging moments, he kept his sense of humor, kindness, and unwavering love for his family. He is predeceased by his parents, Clyde and Jeanne Applegate, and his sister, Cynthia Applegate. He wore his class rings proudly throughout his life.

Dennis was interested in sports of all kinds. He actively played golf and was a member of several bowling leagues throughout the years. Trivia games were of special interest to Dennis. He could answer any sports question from any decade with confidence. Dennis had a competitive nature that made any mundane activity into something fun and worth being a part of.
