Graveside services will be 1:30p.m., Friday, January 29, 2021 at Craig Memorial Park with Father Ken Herzog officiating.

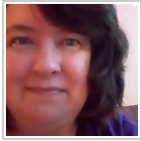

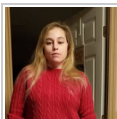
