



## Donald Joseph Suhomske

July 21, 1928 - January 12, 2025

Donald Joseph Suhomske, affectionately known as Don, passed away at the age of 96 on January 12, 2025, in St. Augustine, Florida. He was born on July 21, 1928, in Decatur, Illinois.

Don proudly served in the United States Navy beginning on September 11, 1945. His military career spanned the times of World War II and the Korean War, concluding his service on July 18, 1953.

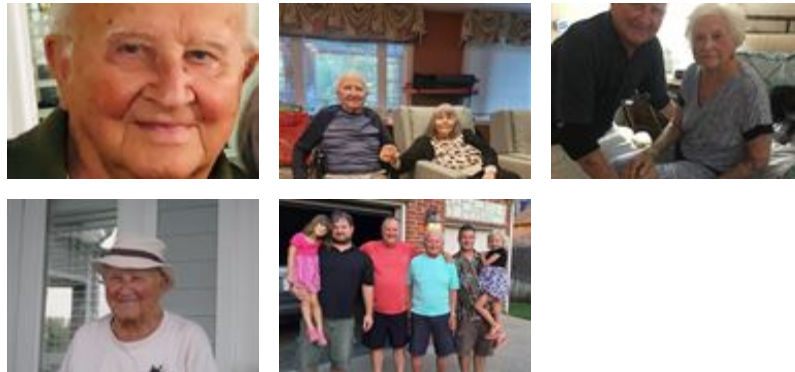
