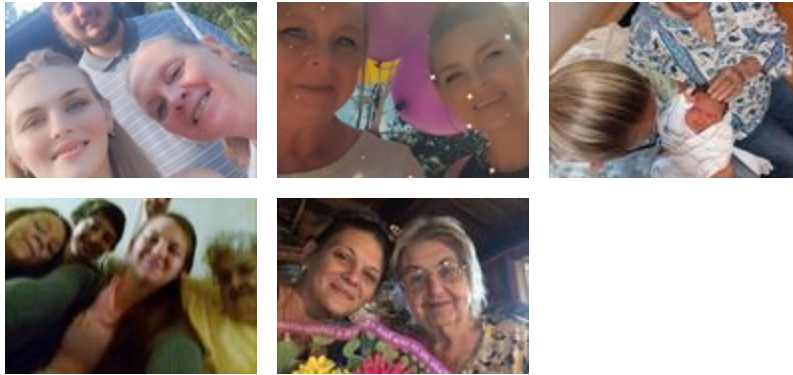
Her Smile
