December 15, 1923 - July 14, 2022

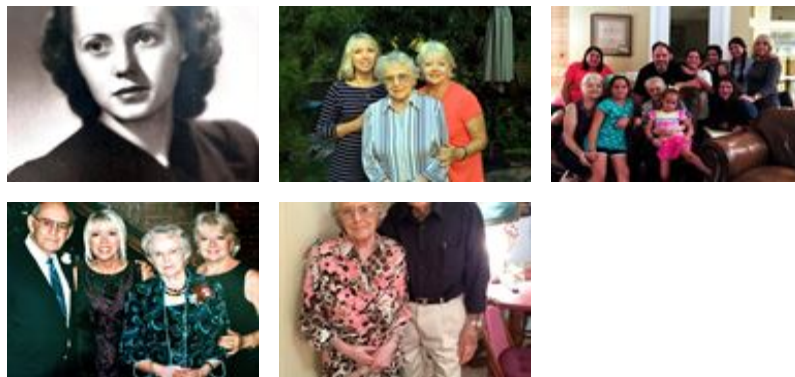
