Edward Andrew Markey, Journeyman Steamfitter, 86, Saint Augustine, died on 11/22/2022 at 2222 in Daytona. He was born in New York City and has resided in Saint Augustine for the past 24 years.

He was a Journeyman Steamfitter with Local 638 in NYC for 41 years. He served proudly in the US Navy as a Radioman Second Class on USS Los Angeles (CA-135). He was a member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church.
