Edward Michael "Ed" Phillips, age 85, of St. Augustine, died on June 12, 2010 at the Earl B. Hadlow Center in Jacksonville. Born in Stuyvesant Falls, N.Y., he was a longtime resident of Poughkeepsie, N.Y., and had been a resident of St. Augustine since 1994. Ed served his family and country with honors. During W.W. II, Ed served in the Army in the European Theater as a half track driver and squad leader during which time he received the Bronze Star and Purple Heart for heroic achievements at the battle of the river Rhine. He returned to civilian life and worked in machine maintenance for at Schatz Federal Bearing in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. for many years and served as President of the Rochdale (N.Y.) Volunteer Fire Dept. He was a member of the American Legion Post 1302 and the Polish American Club in Poughkeepsie and was a member of the V.F.W., the Moose Club and the Council on Aging in St. Augustine. He is survived by his wife, Anita Phillips of St. Augustine; daughters, Brenda Jean Barker and Husband of Pleasant Valley, NY; Tammy McKean and Husband and Cindy Thurston, both of St. Augustine; sons, William D. Phillips and Wife, of Poughkeepsie, NY, Edward M.
