Elizabeth Hinkle Vogler Bielicki, a teacher, mother, sister and daughter, died on Friday, April 23rd at the age of 50 at her home in Jacksonville, Florida.

Elizabeth developed Lyme Disease 14 years ago. She suffered from complications of the disease and also became an advocate for others suffering from Lyme Disease.
