



## Elmer Rutherford Lamoureux

January 4, 1945 - March 16, 2023

Elmer R. Lamoureux, 78, affectionately known as El, entered into the presence of his Lord and Savior in the early morning hours of March 16, 2023. He was a native and lifelong resident of Jacksonville, Florida, born Jan. 4, 1945 to the late Lucien and Edith Lamoureux. After graduating Andrew Jackson High School, El enlisted in the U.S. Army on July 30, 1962 and served his country faithfully for three years, being honorably discharged on July 29, 1965. After his discharge from the U.S. Army, El began a 20 year career in the insurance industry, having worked for New York Life as well as Gulf Life. El loved the Lord, and following his insurance career he began a fulfilling career in ministry. He served as a Chaplain for several Jacksonville hospitals including Shands Jacksonville, Baptist Hospital, and St. Luke's Hospital.
