



Eugene Francis "Bud" Bennett

December 13, 1938 - March 24, 2024

Eugene Francis "Bud" Bennett, Sr., age 85, went home to be with the Lord on March 24, 2024 at his home with his family by his side. He was a native and lifelong resident of St. Augustine, son of the late Chester and Hattie Mae Bennett. "Bud" proudly served his country honorably in the United States Marine Corps. After his discharge from the Marines, he began a lengthy and successful career as a patrolman with the St. Augustine Police Department, retiring in 1991 after 26 years of service. He was a St. Augustine Little League coach for Baker and Hodges Pest Control for 6 years. During that tenure, his teams garnered 2 second place finishes and 4 first place finishes, including an undefeated season in 1982. Many of the players he coached went on to have successful collegiate and professional careers. He was a longtime member of Turning Point at Calvary where he was very active in various ministries, including building many sets and props for Vacation Bible School and other programs. He also loved participating on the softball team in the church softball league. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather, and friend to many. He touched many lives throughout the years and will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

A memorial service to celebrate his life will be held 2:00 p.m. Saturday March 30, 2024 at Turning Point at Calvary, 3500 State Road 16, St. Augustine, FL 32084.

A visitation, beginning at 1:00 p.m., will precede the service.

He is survived by his wife and “sweetheart” of 62 years, Jeffie Bennett, St. Augustine; son, Gene F.
