Francis P. "Frank" Houle, age 72, of St. Augustine, passed away on May 11, 2011 at his daughter's home in St. Augustine. He was born in Winchendon, Massachusetts and was a longtime resident of Ashburnham, MA, moving to St. Augustine in 1979. He served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps after the Korean War. Upon moving to St. Augustine he worked for the City of St. Augustine Parks Dept. and briefly for the City Water Dept. For more than 17 years, Frank served as a Deputy with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Dept., retiring in 2000.
