Frankie Manucy Pacetti, 82, passed on from this world March 14, 2024 following a brief illness. A loving and fearless mother, wife, sister, friend and grandmother, she will be dearly missed.

Frankie was a native and life-long resident of St. Augustine. She worked in advertising sales for eighteen years at the St. Augustine Record. She later owned and operated Frankie's Hair Shack until her retirement.

Throughout her life, Frankie was a straight talker, a mostly straight shooter and a woman of great integrity and love.

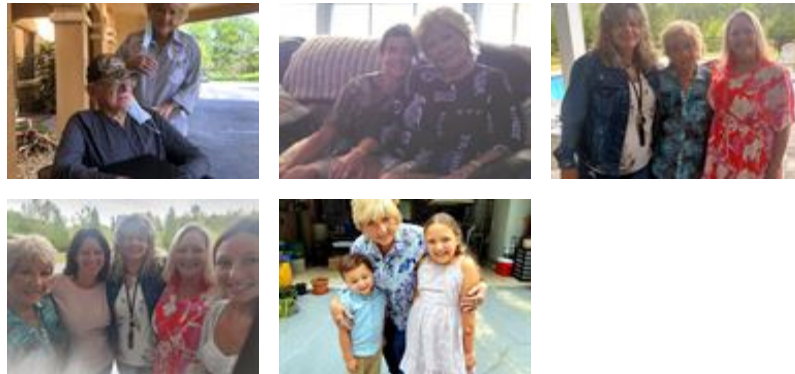
