Frederick H. Allen, 76, a resident of Opelika, AL and St. Augustine, FL, died October 15, 2012 surrounded by his family at the Bailey Family Center for Caring. A native and long time resident of Opelika, he began living in St. Augustine part time last year. He served his country honorably in the U.S Coast Guard, retiring as a Chief Warrant Officer after 28 years of proud service in 1982. He was a veteran of Vietnam. Following his retirement from the service he began working for Lifecycle Engineering in Charleston, SC until retiring in 1993. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Opelika, the Chief Warrant Officers Association, the U.S. Coast Guard Ingham Association, and the Retired Officers Association. Funeral services will be held 10:30 a.m. Friday October 19, 2012 at St. Johns Family Funeral Home with Bishop LaVoy Newton and son-in-law, Donald Grundy officiating. A visitation with the family will begin at 10:00 a.m. Friday, preceding the services.
