Frederick Earl "Fred" Harllee III, age 69, of Ponte Vedra Beach, passed away unexpectedly on Dec. 5, 2014 at his residence. Fred was born in Charleston, S.C. and grew up in Greensboro, N.C. He graduated from University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill with a Bachelor Degree in Business Administration and served his country in the U.S. Army during Vietnam War. After his discharge from the Army he graduated from U.N.C. at Greensboro with a M.B.A. For many years Fred worked in Greensboro as a Commercial Real Estate Developer for Jefferson Pilot where he retired as Vice President of the Real Estate Division in 1996. Upon his retirement, he moved to Ponte Vedra Beach and remained active as a consultant in the local residential and commercial real estate industry and served as a Adjunct Professor at the U.N.F. Coggin College of Business. He was especially close with his "extended family" at the Palm Valley American Legion Post 233. More than anything he was a loving father and friend to many, and will be deeply missed.
