The Rev. Dr. Frederick C. Harrison, 1922-2016 In June of 1956, he was ordained deacon by The Rt. Rev. Richard Henry Baker and ordained as priest in January of 1957 by the Rt. Rev. Edwin A. Penick . Born in 1922 in South Bend, Indiana, he is a graduate of Florida International University and holds an M.Div. from Virginia Theological Seminary, Ph. D. from Walden University and a D.D. from his seminary in 1994. He married Lucille S. Lanni in 1973. He is survived by his wife, sons Frederick K. Harrison, Richard L. Harrison (Vana), Russell S. Harrison (Yvette), son Christopher predeceased him, Thomas C. Lanni (Monica), William F. Lanni (Joy), and grandchildren, Rebecca, Rachel, Graham, Shanna, Christopher, Lischar, Jedidiah. He served as rector of St. Andrew's, Charlotte, and as Chaplain for Illinois State Penitentiary System. Father Harrison had a long career in counseling. He was founder and Executive Director of Spectrum Programs, Miami; established Unity House in Auburn, N.Y, from 1974-1978 and founder and Executive Director of the Church Counseling Center in Naples. 1979-1984. From 1960-1968 he served as chaplain at the Illinois State Penitentiary System. He served churches in North Carolina where he was priested January 12, 1957, Illinois, New York, and in Florida St. Stephens, Miami, Trinity by the Cove, Naples, St. Luke's, Fort Myers, Holy Faith in Dunnellon, Trinity in St. Augustine.
