Frieda Hesse "Fritzie" Kramer, age 91, of St. Augustine, passed away on April 27, 2010 at Acosta-Rua Center for Caring in Jacksonville. She was born on February 11, 1919 in Downers Grove, Illinois. She was married to the late Duke Kramer for 63 years, and they lived much of their lives in Naperville, Illinois, moving to Cincinnati, Ohio in 1971. She was active in the Naperville school system and volunteered at Naperville and Cincinnati hospitals. She and her husband owned D & F Products, a distributor of vintage Gretsch guitar products. She loved playing golf and bridge, and was a longtime member of Coldstream Country Club in Cincinnati. According to her family, her greatest accomplishment was her unconditional love for them. Their tribute to her is a quote of her response to the question: "If you could come back as anyone, who would it be?" Fritzie's answer was, "Myself." She was preceded in death by her husband, Duke; a grandson Brian; a twin sister; two other sisters and one brother. She is survived by her two sons, Ken "KC" Kramer and his wife, Gail, of St. Augustine; Scott Kramer and his wife, Stella, of Fredericksburg, Virginia; a daughter, Susan Hamilton, and her husband, Dale, of Nantucket, Massachusetts; four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. Private family services will be held, with interment taking place at a later date at Beaufort National Cemetery in Beaufort, South Carolina.
