Gail S. Ward, age 82, of St. Augustine, passed away on Sunday, April 22, 2018 at her son's home surrounded by her family. She was born in Eufaula, AL. to William Earl and Gladys Adcock Smith in 1935, attended public school, graduated from Eufaula High School and attended Auburn University. At an early age, she professed her faith in Jesus Christ and was Baptized at the Washington Street Methodist Church where she later married Bob Ward, "the love of her life". Together, they were the loving parents of five children: Gladys Anne, Ed, Earl, Beth, and David. The Family moved to St Augustine in 1967, where Bob built a thriving Agricultural Supply Business (Ward Ag Products), and Gail became one of the most successful Avon Representatives in the area. She won multiple Mrs. Albee Presidents Awards after achieving record sales for many years. After Bob's passing in 1994, Gail answered the call to open "The Wonder of Truth" Christian Bookstore. Her passion to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and serve the Christian community through the bookstore was her ministry for many years. Gail was also the President of Farmers Realty in Hastings. It's often been said that the heartfelt prayers of a Mother for her Children and Family are one of the most beautiful and powerful forces in the universe. Gail started that practice at an early age, reading Bible stories to her siblings: Earl, Carol, Jeannine, and Tyson. No matter what stage of life, or circumstance took her, she remained a steadfast servant of the Lord,

sharing the love of Christ in various Children and Adult ministries. Without a doubt however, no love filled her heart more than that of her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. She devoted herself tirelessly to making sure that they knew exactly how much God loves them through her unselfish love. Her daughters-in-law always looked to her as another "Mother" instead of a Mother in law which is a Blessing only someone like Gail could provide. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert Edward Ward, Jr., and a daughter, Gladys Ann Ward.
