May 29, 1944 - August 17, 2024

Gayle Wasson Greene, age 80, passed away peacefully on August 17, 2024, at UF Health St. Johns. Born in Jacksonville, Florida, on May 29, 1944, she was the beloved daughter of the late Louis and Orel Wasson. Gayle spent the majority of her life in St. Augustine, where she became an integral part of the community.

A proud graduate of St. Augustine High School Class of 1962, Gayle continued her education at St. Luke's Hospital in Jacksonville, where she earned her nursing degree in 1965. Her compassionate care touched many lives during her career, with dedicated service at St. Augustine General Hospital, Flagler Hospital, and Memorial Hospital.

On November 6, 1965, Gayle married her soulmate, Steve Greene, whom she met at Jacksonville University. Together, they built a loving family and a life filled with cherished memories. Gayle was a lifelong member of the St. Augustine Church of Christ, where she actively participated in church activities and formed lasting friendships.

Beyond her professional and spiritual commitments, Gayle had a passion for cooking, gardening, and reading. Her greatest joy came from spending time with her family, where her warmth and nurturing spirit will be fondly remembered.
