“ For very small window in my life I had the privilege of knowing George Judge. We didn't grow up together or attend the same college. We weren't related and never worked for the same employer. We met somewhat by chance simply because we were in the same profession, each of us near the end of our careers. The camaraderie and mutual respect were immediate. We shared some common life experiences and a dry sense of humor. I will never forget some of his one liners and the situations in which they were uttered. My wife and I took the opportunity to visit George and Linda when they lived in Casa Grande, Arizona, as part of a trip to visit family in Yuma. They were the most wonderful hosts and we were blessed to stay with them for a few days both coming and going. We took many photographs on that trip and one photo opportunity will always be in my memory.
