Gladys Jane Blouin nee Cotter, 90, of St Augustine, Passed away peacefully at her residence on Wednesday, July 15, 2020. Gladys was born on November 1, 1929 in Curraclough, Co. Cork, Ireland. She was one of 9 children born to the late Richard and Ethel Cotter.

Gladys immigrated to the United States in 1957 and worked for GHI, a medical insurance company, for 37 years before moving to St. Augustine in 2006. Gladys was an active member of St Anastasia Catholic Church.
