Guy Dudley, age 49, of St. Augustine, died at his home on Friday morning, February 17, 2012. Guy was the youngest of four children born to Rex and Frances Dudley in Fernandina Beach, FL. They moved to St. Augustine in 1979, and Guy graduated from St. Augustine High School in 1982. He spent the last 15 of his working years at the Florida School for the Deaf & Blind. Guy is survived by his daughter, Griffin Lee Anne Dudley; his mother, Frances Dudley; a brother, Jerry Dudley and two sisters, Donna Dudley and Noree Hart. There will be a visitation from 4 to 6 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 24th, at St. Johns Family Funeral Home. An open house memorial gathering for Guy will follow the visitation from 7 to 10 p.m. on Friday, at the home of his sister, Donna Dudley, 38 Macaris St., St. Augustine, FL 32084.
