Harold K. "Hal" Terry, DMD, age 95, of St. Augustine, died on December 15, 2011 at his residence in World Golf Village. Born and raised in Bahama, North Carolina, Hal graduated from Duke University with a B.S. degree and later earned his DMD from Harvard University School of Dentistry. He served as a dentist in the U.S. Navy during World War II, and enjoyed a long career as an Orthodontist. A resident of Miami since the early 1940's, Dr. Terry simultaneously maintained orthodontic offices in Miami, S. Miami, and Ft. Lauderdale, as well as in Freeport and Nassau, Bahamas for many decades. He was a longtime member of Kiwanis, The Miami Pioneers Natives of Dade, and had served as President of The Southern Society of Orthodontics as well as The American Association of Orthodontics. He had relocated to St. Augustine three years ago where he was a member of the Village Church. He is survived by a daughter, Janet Terry Patterson of Glen Ellyn, Illinois; son, James L. Terry and his wife Dr. Deborah F. Terry whom Hal cherished and loved dearly, sons Thomas Terry and Paul Terry, all of St. Augustine; four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren and a sister-in-law Ennis Terry of Bahama, N.C.
