Harry Lloyd Kelly, age 82, of St Augustine, FL passed away on September 18, 2018 at Flagler Hospital. Harry was a native of Florence, SC. He left home at the age of 17 to join the US Navy and served in the Korean War. After his honorable discharge from the Navy, Harry returned home to Florence, S.C. For most of his adult life, Harry worked in the aluminum manufacturing industry. His work moved him to many different places around the country including New Jersey and Massachusetts. In 1979, Harry moved his family to St. Augustine, FL. to help open the VAW Aluminum Plant where he worked until his retirement in 2003. His retirement however was short lived. After a couple of months vacationing and cruising the Caribbean, Harry went straight back to work for Advance Auto Parts as a Delivery Driver. He loved to work, but more than anything he loved being around people. He was also very community minded having served as a volunteer fire fighter for many years, and was President of Station 11 in the 1980's. Harry had the heart of a good father and was a father to many who were fatherless. He was a member of Anastasia Baptist Church for 30 years and was currently a member of Crescent Beach Baptist Church. One of the highlights of Harry's life was going on a Tiger cruise with his brother in 1999 from Hawaii to California on board the U.S. Navy carrier, USS Constellation. Harry was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend to many and he will be deeply missed.
