Harvey Jay Hambleton, age 75, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away surrounded by his family on February 1, 2011, at the Bailey Center for Caring at Flagler Hospital. Born and raised in Buffalo, New York, he was a graduate of Nichols Prep School in Buffalo and was a graduate of Dartmouth College with a degree in Earth Sciences. A Rhodes Scholar, and member of Sigma Phi Epsilon, he went on to receive Masters degrees in Geology from both Yale and Penn State University. He worked for a time as a graduate assistant at the Florida State University Geology Department before becoming employed as a Curator of Geology for the Buffalo Museum of Science for five years. He later went to work for his family's business, as a loan officer for People Loan in Buffalo, an occupation he continued for many years. Harvey and his family relocated to St. Augustine in 1991. He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Sabra Hambleton; a daughter, Becki Hambleton; and sons, Herb Hambleton, and his wife, Cindy, and Jay Hambleton, all of St. Augustine.
